MARCH 17, 2020 UPDATES

As the Islip School District continues to navigate the unchartered and ever-changing waters of the coronavirus pandemic, we will strive to provide timely updates to our community. These will be posted in the "scroll" on the District website, and social media notices will be sent once an update is live.

Here is what you need to know today:

- Governor Andrew M. Cuomo has signed an executive order directing all schools in New York to close until Wednesday, April 1st. This will extend the closure directed by County Executive Bellone over the weekend by two days.
- Starting on Wednesday, March 18th, our Department of Food & Nutrition will offer an emergency feeding program for all district students. Families with students registered in the district may pick up 'grab and go' breakfasts and lunches at Islip High School (2508 Union Boulevard) cafeteria, Mondays-Fridays, between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. All children aged 1-18 living in an Islip household are eligible for meals. Please see the letter linked on the <u>Coronavirus Information</u> <u>page</u> for full details.
 - You may drive or walk up to the distribution site, located at the HS cafeteria. Please enter campus through the western gate on Union Boulevard near the entrance to Buccaneer Stadium, and then proceed through the student parking lot to the doors near the HS cafeteria, exiting campus through the eastern gate.

- Even though our schools are closed to teachers and students, members of our essential administrative team will be reporting to their offices and/or working remotely to keep the district running. Due to limited staffing and access, however, some requests, such as those for official transcripts or student records, will not be able to be fulfilled at this time. Unofficial transcripts can be sent. Phone calls to some offices may go unanswered, as well. If you need to contact any staff members, check the <u>online Staff Directory</u> for an email address. Please understand that our aim is to keep all of our Islip family safe and healthy.

- The Guidance Department will be sending out information on Advanced Placement (AP) exams when it becomes available. The May SAT has been cancelled. If your student registered for the April ACT, please check your email for information regarding changing your registration to the June or July administration date.
