To begin, there will be two Zoom meetings on September 10th. One will be for the parents of K-1 students and one for parents of grades 2-5. These meetings are with our technology specialists to review all of your in-home devices and technology needs. We will also introduce our Infinite Campus Student Management System. You will receive a Zoom link via email to be able to join the meeting. - 2-5 students: 10:15 – 11:15 a.m.


