**Please note schedules will NOT be changed to accommodate requests including, but not limited to, changing of lunch periods, gym periods, changing classes to be with friends or for specific teacher requests and/or periods.**

ALL COURSE CHANGES will be on a five (5) day hold. This INCLUDES, class level changes and/or dropping of electives. The only exception will be for those students who were placed incorrectly in a course.
